Exodus 14:15 (NLT)

*Then the LORD said to Moses, "Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to **get moving!**"*

Factors That Discourage Movement:

- Negative People! Exodus 14:11 (NLT)
- Focusing on the Past! Exodus 14:12 (NLT)
- Pessimism! Exodus 14:15 (NLT)
- Procrastination! Exodus 14:15-16 (MSG)

Focus Points That Encourage Movement:

[1] **God's _____!**

(Exodus 3:8 (NLT))

- In His presence, we discover His promises!

(Exodus 3:7-8 NLT)

- In His presence, we discover His precepts!

Exodus 14:16 (NLT)

Pick up your staff and raise your hand over the sea. Divide the water so the Israelites can walk through the middle of the sea on dry ground.

[2] God's _____!

- In His providence, we face challenges beyond our ability to solve.

Exodus 14:4 (NLT)

And once again I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and he will chase after you, I have planned this in order to display my glory through Pharaoh and his whole army. After this the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD!" So the Israelites camped there as they were told.

- In His providence, He will fight for us.

Exodus 14:13-14 (NLT)

But Moses told the people, "Don't be afraid. Just stand still and watch the Lord rescue you today. The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again. [14] The Lord himself will fight for you. Just stay calm."

Exodus 14:21, 25b (NLT)

Then Moses raised his hand over the sea, and the Lord opened up a path through the water with a strong east wind. The wind blew all that night, turning the seabed into dry land... "The Lord is fighting for them against Egypt!"
